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
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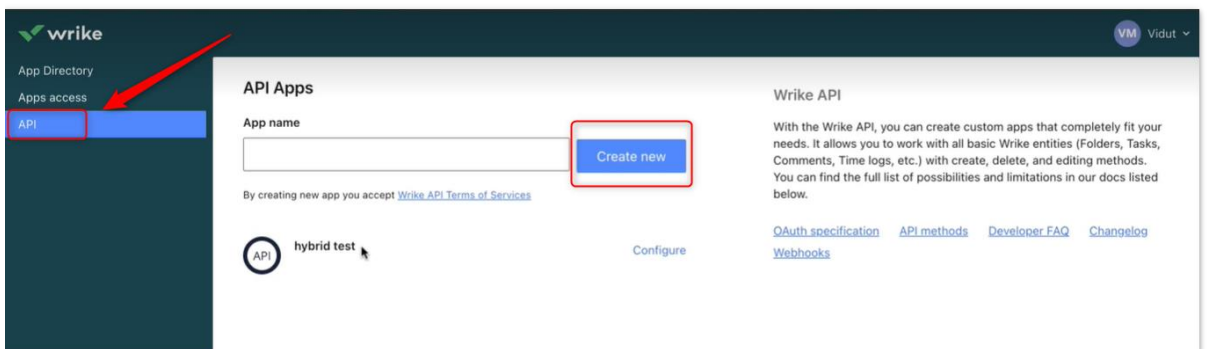
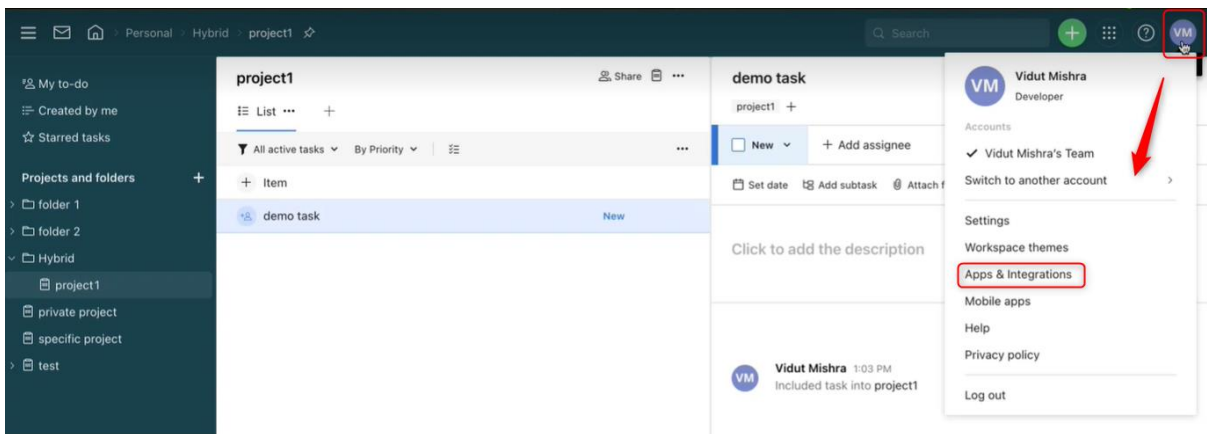


Wrike API Integration


1. This allows you to receive notifications on the Hybrid when there is any change in the folder associated with the project in the Wrike application.
2. To integrate Wrike into the **'Kloudspot Hybrid Work'**, an application token is required.
3. To add it, navigate to the **Advanced Settings** page, then to **Configuration -> Hybrid Settings > Application Integrations** then scroll down and find the **Wrike API Access**.



4. To obtain the application token, follow the instructions.
5. Log in to the Wrike developer account with company credentials.
6. Navigate to **My Profile > Apps & Integrations > API**. Enter your App name and click **Create new** button.



7. In the App configuration window that opens, enter the App description, and click the **Create token** button.



- In the popup window that appears, enter the Wrike login password and click the **Obtain token** button.

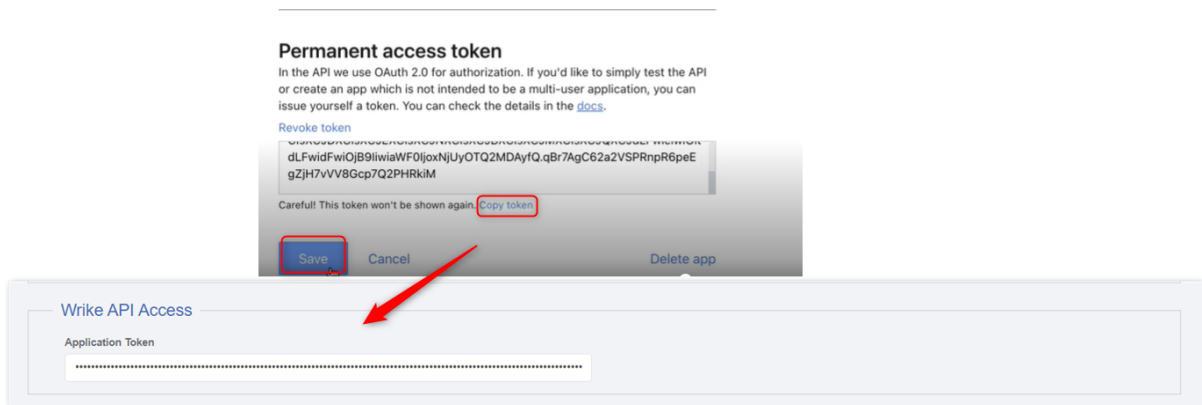

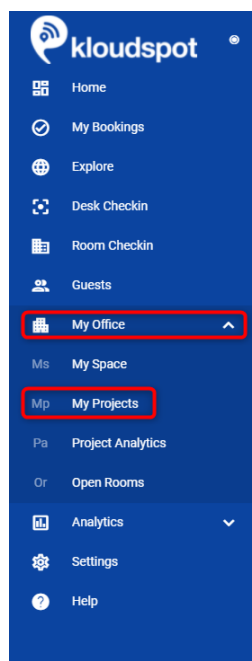
- Copy the generated token and paste it into the Advanced settings.

11. Wrike API is integrated successfully.

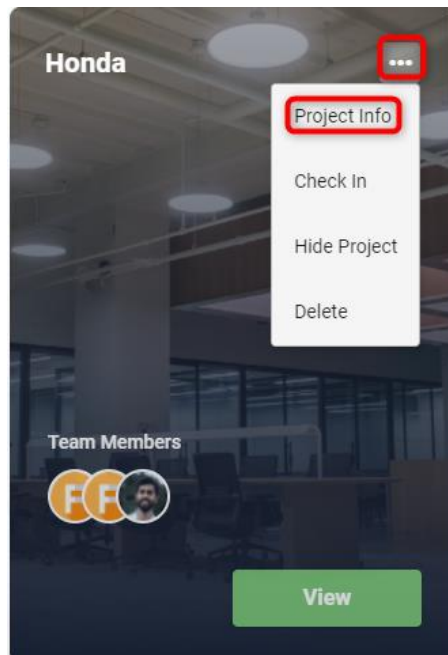
To add Wrike in integrated Apps.

1. Navigate to **My Office > My Project** and Go to the **info page** of the project for which you want to add the Wrike.

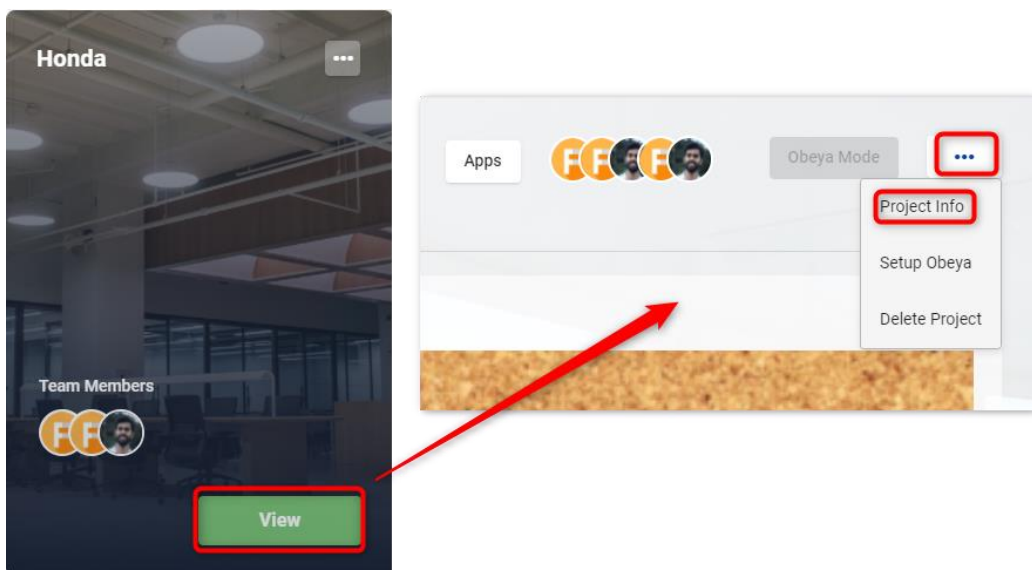


2. There are 2 ways to access the Project Info page.

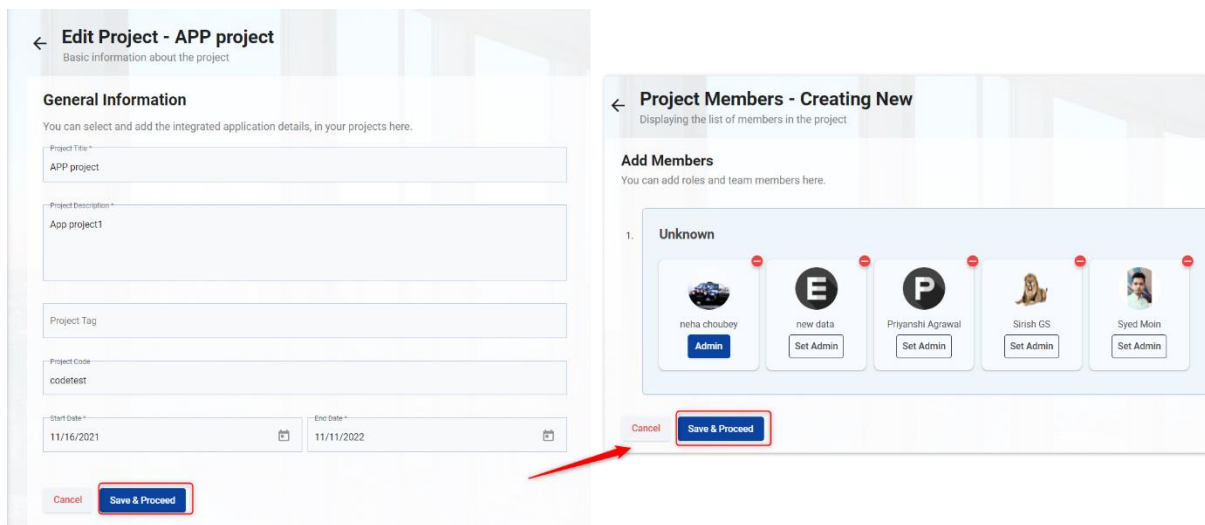
- a. Click on the **Menu button > Project info**.



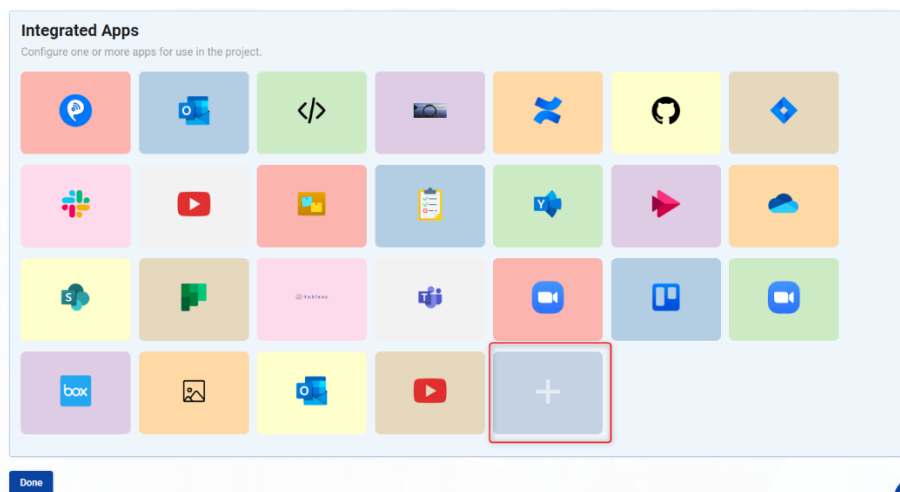
b. Click **View** > menu button > **Project info**.



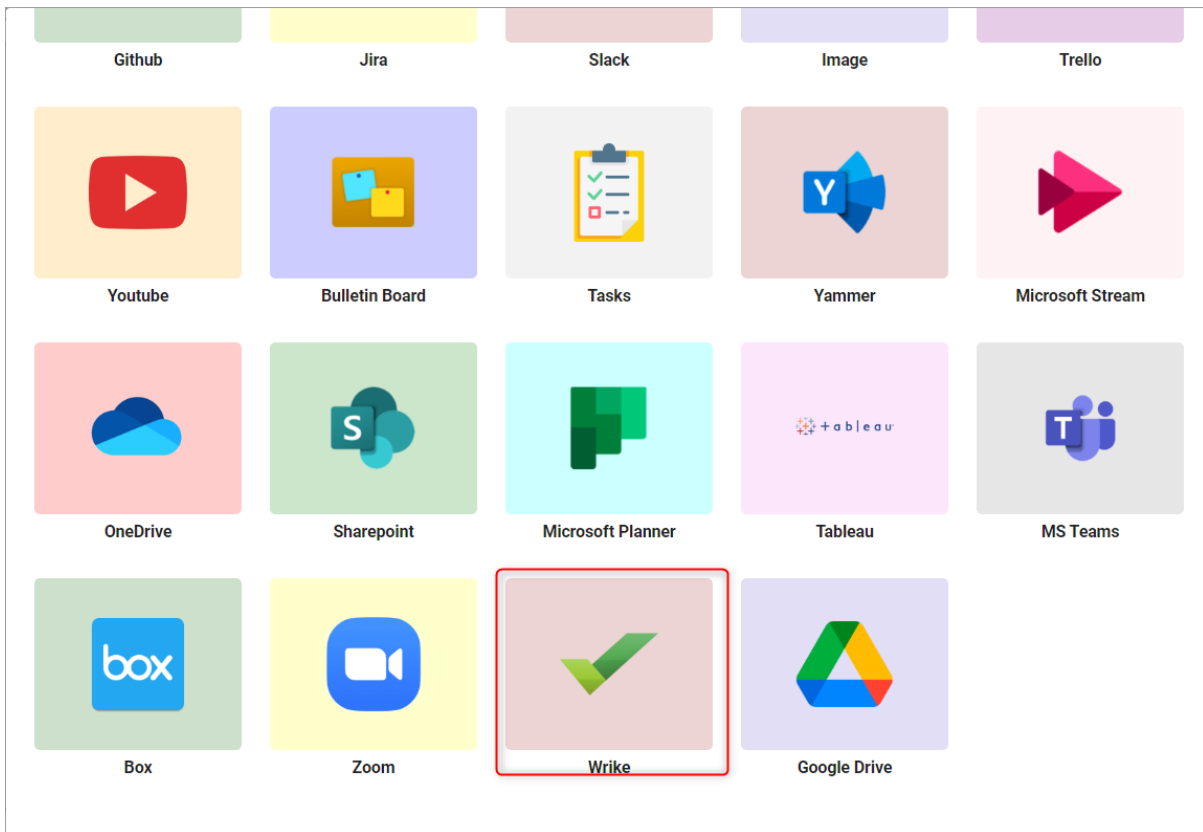
3. Click the **Save & continue** button until Project Apps appear.




4. In the Project App window that opens, click the **Add** button in the Integrated Apps section.



5. Locate and click on the **Wrike** app, in the pop-up window that appears.



6. Copy the Wrike folder URL and paste it into the URL section.
Note: When you click on the Wrike App from the home page, this URL helps you determine which page to redirect.
7. Check the **Enable Notifications** checkbox in the Resource window that opens.
8. Select the folder name from the drop-down list and click **submit** button. Updates to that folder will be notified to project members.



9. Wrike notification is enabled successfully.
